
- Fair Employment for Migrant Workers

STUDENT EVALUATION

In student evaluations, there are 100% students strongly agree and agree that the internship experience is fruitful in Summer 2022, we observed an improving score from Term-time 2022 (67%) and Summer 2021 (85%).



Process



#1 TRAINING WORKSHOPS

Pre-internship workshops to equip students with understanding of the SDGs framework and related issues



#2 REFLECTIVE MEETINGS

While students are out for community work, regular reflective meetings to guide them through the exploration process



#3 E-LEARNING MODULES

Develop e-modules on to encourage students for selfpaced learning, assist the delivery of academic deliverables



#4 MULTI-MEDIA PRESENTATION

Critically assessed the impact of the internship experience or CPs' work on the SDGs
