# SaP CoP Aims & Objectives



#### Aim:

 The development and implementation of "Students as Partners" (SaP) through a University-wide supporting Community of Practice (CoP) for education

#### **Objectives:**

- 1. Share experience of existing SaP projects through seminars in progress
- 2. Compile a mapping document of existing SaPs across the university -in progress
- 3. Develop frameworks on: "Process" and "Levels" and SCOPE for SaP in progress
- 4. Help engage/support colleagues develop their own initiative on SaPs to be done
- 5. Publish on SaP initiatives across the university to be done
- 6. Evaluate outcomes of SaPs to be done

## 2.2 Credits Recognition

1 Credit	20- 30 hours of learning
(not on transcript)	Map to at least 1 UEA
2 Credits	50 hours or more of learning
(not on transcript)	Map to at least 1 UEA
3 Credits (on transcript, not included in the GPA calculation)	1+1+1 or 1+2/ 2+1

Survey to be sent out to students and teachers

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#### Requirements:

- transcriptable credits in blocks of three
- upper limit is six credits
- **one application per activity,** no duplicate applications for the same activity
- Odd credits not in units of 3 go into AAP.
